SCHEDULE

The 2018 Pourparler officially opens on Thursday Nov. 1 at 4 pm for registration, plus meeting/greeting/eating snacks. At 6:30, we'll have dinner followed by a relaxed, convivial dance party led by your hosts and other long time attendees.

On Friday, Saturday and Sunday, we will share dances and songs, discuss relevant interests and concerns, and network with one another. Everyone contributes—this is not led by experts, but a sharing of materials and resources for teaching dance and music activities to all ages in a variety of settings.

On Saturday evening, we will all participate in a community dance with calling by members of Pourparler (includes longways set dances, play-party dances, squares, mixers, and circle dances).

On Sunday morning, we will continue our sessions, ending officially at noon with lunch.

DANCE SHARING

Dance sharing is the heart and soul of the Pourparler. All are invited to present a dance or two; you are also welcome to participate but not teach anything. We'll send a follow-up message this fall with directions for how to submit dances, music, games, movement activities, or songs for our program. Everyone is encouraged to contribute ideas, experiences and other useful comments during discussions.

RESOURCES

You are welcome to bring your own professional dance and music resources for others to purchase. There will also be space for participants to display flyers, and other information.

J MUSIC

Live music is encouraged at the Pourparler whenever possible; excellent ethnic music recordings are also respected. We encourage all musicians to bring their instruments for the Pourparler band, and to let us know in advance what instruments they will play.

HOUSING CHOICES (not included in Pourparler program fee)

DORMS:

Rooms are available on campus in one of Our Lady of the Lake's (OLLU) dorms (right across the street from the workshop), the rate is \$25 per bed per night, with double occupancy. If you want to be alone in the room, you pay for the other bed, a total of \$50 per night. Each room has two twin beds and shares a bathroom with the room next door. Attendees will share rooms and bathrooms with same-gender attendees. If there are married couples who wish to stay in the dorm, they will share a bathroom with another married couple. Unmarried couples may not share a dorm room and will need to seek lodging elsewhere. The dorms are 3-story and have no elevator, so first-floor rooms are reserved for wheelchair and walker users. Dorm rooms do not include any amenities so bring your own shampoo, soap, towels, bath mat, hair dryer, etc. Linen can be rented from OLLU for \$7 per set. The IFCC has extra blankets, since the dorms tend to be cold. If you are driving to Pourparler, please bring your own linens. The dorm rooms are spartanbut you can't beat the price and the commute!

Deadline for registering and paying for a dorm room is October 28th.
